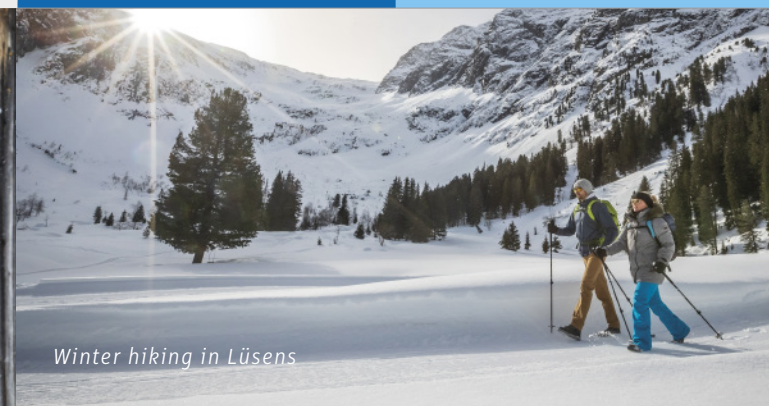

HOW AND WHERE CAN I GET THE CARD? CAN I ALSO BUY THE WELCOME CARD?

The Welcome Card is available free of charge **directly from your accommodation provider**. A list of partner establishments can be found at www.innsbruck.info/welcome. The Welcome Card is linked to the registration of guests at the property. With the "Welcome Card / Welcome Card plus", Innsbruck Tourismus has created an offer that is available to every accommodation provider in the region. Each provider is free to decide whether or not to offer the Card to guests: Innsbruck Tourismus has no influence on the decision. For stays of three or more nights you will automatically receive the Welcome Card plus from partner establishments free of charge. **The Welcome Card / Welcome Card plus cannot be purchased, nor can the Card be issued by tourist information offices.**

CAN I GET THE WELCOME CARD BEFORE MY HOLIDAY AND CAN I USE THE CARD ON THE DAY OF ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE?

It is possible for you to obtain your Welcome Card before you arrive. To do so you must contact your accommodation provider in advance. The Card is valid on both the day of arrival and departure. The Card can also be used multiple times provided there is no limit on the use of a specific service. Please take note of any restrictions on usage! HOW DO I KNOW WHICH PUBLIC TRANSPORT SERVICES CAN BE USED FREE OF CHARGE WITH THE WELCOME CARD?

All lines of the Verkehrsverbund Tirol (VVT) and the Innsbrucker Verkehrsbetriebe* (IVB) are included as well as the regional trains of the Austrian Federal Railways (ÖBB) **within the Innsbruck region**. A detailed list of all included services as well as the end points to which the Welcome Card is valid as a travel ticket can be found at www.innsbruck.info/welcome.

CAN BICYCLES BE TAKEN ON PUBLIC TRANSPORT AND IS THIS ALSO INCLUDED IN THE WELCOME CARD?

- ▶ It is generally possible and permitted to transport bicycles on ÖBB trains. A separate ticket, not included in the Welcome Card, is however required. The additional bike ticket is available as a day or weekly ticket and can be purchased in the VVT ticket shop, ÖBB ticket shop or at vending machines.
- ▶ Provided space is available, bikes may be taken free of charge on vehicles on city lines in Innsbruck's core zone and on the tram to the Stubaital valley (IVB) at the following times: from 9.00 am to 3.00 pm and from 6.30 pm to 6.00 am on Mondays to Fridays, and all day on Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays. If a bus has a bike rack at the rear bicycles may be carried at any time.
- ▶ Provided space is available, bikes may be taken free of charge on low-floor buses on VVT bus lines. If the bus has a bike rack at the rear it must be used.
- ▶ Bicycle transport cannot be guaranteed, especially inside the vehicle, as other user groups (e.g. wheelchair users or prams) always have priority: transport of bikes is at the driver's discretion.

DOES THE WELCOME CARD HAVE TO BE STAMPED WHEN USED AS A TICKET ON PUBLIC TRANSPORT?

No, the Welcome Card does not have to be stamped. It simply has to be presented if required for inspection.

ARE THE SERVICES OF THE WELCOME CARD INCLUDED IN THE WELCOME CARD PLUS?

Yes, as well as the Oberperfuss cable cars, all services are included where these are offered for stays of two nights and more.

CAN I GO DIRECTLY THROUGH THE CABLE CAR TURNSTILES WITH THE WELCOME CARD PLUS OR DO I HAVE TO BUY A TICKET AT THE CASH DESK BEFOREHAND?

Yes, direct entry is possible. In case of technical difficulties please contact the cash desk.

Oberperfuss cable car (Section I + II), Oberperfuss (Rangger Köpfl)

- 1 return trip for hikers and tobogganists per stay (toboggan carriage permitted)
- Direct access to the cable car at the turnstile with the Welcome Card plus: it is not necessary to exchange it for a cable car ticket at the cash desk

Located just a short distance from Innsbruck, the Rangger Köpfl offers a unique panorama far over the Inntal valley.

Whether for leisurely winter hikes on the two groomed winter hiking trails high up on the mountain, or for a rapid toboggan run down into the valley, the mountain with its magnificent views offers all sorts of winter fun for mountain lovers both large and small!
